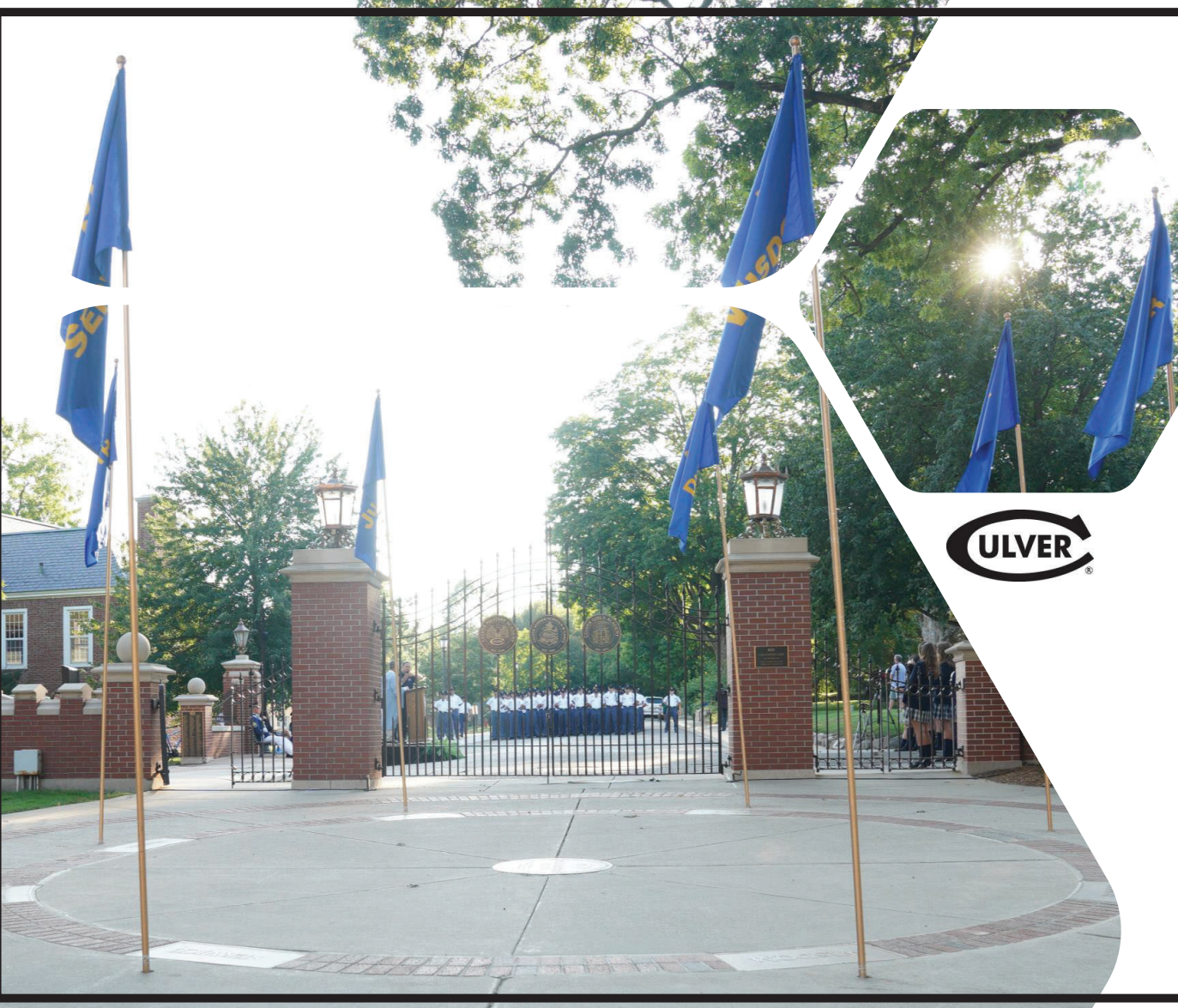
Grade 12 (1 term, 1 day/week)
